






Local Hotels (Option 3)

- Located 1 mile from Newport Naval Complex, this hotel is 10 minutes' drive from central Newport. Rooms feature free Wi-Fi. Guests staying at the Newport Inn can enjoy a swim in the outdoor pool. Rooms at Middletown Newport Inn offer cable TV, a microwave, and refrigerator. Each spacious room also provides a desk with chair. Select rooms feature a spa bath. 



Blue Team - Rules of Engagement


- Don't modify the RWU network
 - Changing setting, which ports are used, etc.
- Do not access other teams environments
- Each system has a "black-team" user/role. Do not remove or restrict
 access as they are used for scoring & remote assistance
- Complies with the <u>National CCDC rules</u>



Red Team - Rules of Engagement

Out-of-Scope

- Competition Network switches
- RWU Network (Wired & Wi-Fi)
- Competition Workstations (blue team laptops)
- Specific Team Accounts: Google Classroom & Discord

Competition Access

- The infrastructure will be accessible directly from the RWU network
 - Wireguard will be used as a fallback in case of an issue during deployment
- Credentials will be released as soon as competition begins

Software Pre-installed

- Laptops will come pre-installed with common utilities
 - SSH, Nmap, web browsers, VSCode, RDP software
- Discord

- Please notify Black Team if other issues occur that impact your ability to participate




